# **Organised and Promoted by County Cavan Motor Club Ltd.**

## **ORGANISATION**

1. The Bailie Hotel sponsored Cavan Motor Club Restricted Mini Stages Rally is promoted and organised by County Cavan Motor Club Ltd. (hereinafter called the promoters), and will cover a route of approximately 50 road kms and 60 Stage kms.
2. These Regulations have been submitted to and approved by Motorsport Ireland and the necessary permit for the holding of the Competition has been granted.

## **ARTICLES**

### **Article 1**

The Competition will be held under the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A. and the General Competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland and these supplementary regulations including Appendixes "N" (Rally Code) & "O" (Standard Regulations for all Stage Rallies) of the Current Year Book All Competitors who forward completed Entry Forms agree to be bound by the rules.

### **Article 2**

- (A) The Supplementary Regulations for the Rally are stated by the Motorsport Ireland Regulations and Definitions 2007 year Book. Copies of the book can be obtained from Motorsport Ireland, Competitions Department, 34 Dawson Street, Dublin 2, Ireland
- (B) Final Instructions will form an integral part of the Supplementary Regulations.

### **Article 3**

- (A) Entries open on publication of the Supplementary Regulations.
- (B) All entries must be made on the official entry form, properly completed and posted with entry fee to: Nikki Sherlock, 47 The Beeches, Drumgola Wood, Cavan. The Entry Fee for the event is **€400.00** which includes Personal Accident Insurance and Standard IRDS Insurance. Cheques may only be post dated to 12<sup>th</sup> of September 2007. Cheques should be made payable to County Cavan Motor Club.
- (C) The Club reserves the right to refuse an entry without assigning a reason.
- (D) Entries are confined to 150 received. In the event of more than 150 entries being received priority will be given as follows:
  - (i) As per Appendix "O" Article 2.6, Motorsport Ireland 2007 Year Book
- (E) The Remaining entries will be placed on a reserve list

### **Article 4**

There is a Parc Ferme in operation on Saturday 22nd of September 2007 which is located at Bailieborough Community Secondary School.

## Article 5

### NOTICE BOARD

The official Notice Board will be situated in the Rally Office & will be in operation from 09:00 hrs on Sat 22nd September 2007 until 30 minutes after the event prize giving. Prior to the event [www.cocavanmotorclub.com](http://www.cocavanmotorclub.com) & [www.rally.ie](http://www.rally.ie) will be updated with information on the rally.

## Article 6

### RECONNAISSANCE / PACE NOTE MAKING

Pace notes will be allowed on the event and competitors will be allowed to make notes on Saturday September 22<sup>nd</sup> 2007 between 10:30hrs and 15:30hrs.

Competitors must sign on at rally headquarters between 10:30 hrs and 13:00 hrs.

Pace notes will be available for sale by Third Parties. The club has no involvement in their preparation and accepts no responsibility or liability for their accuracy or otherwise.

You will be supplied with two reconnaissance identification stickers, **which must be placed on the front and rear windows when you are commencing your recce/pace note making, where they are clearly visible.**

“Judges of Fact” will patrol the Stages. Speeding and use of the handbrake to negotiate acute turns will not be tolerated. Respect for residents is essential for the safe running of this event. Your attention is drawn to Appendix “O”, Regulation 4.6 (a) & (b).

The decision of a “Judge of Fact” will be final. Judges of Fact may ask to sign your Road Book.

A list of “Judges of Fact” will be posted on the Official Rally Notice Board

Your attention is also drawn to appendix “O”, Regulation 4.8 (a), (b), (c), (d), referring to a competitor found on a Stage outside of the “Recce” period, also refer to 4.9 – 4.10.

Reports of breaches of this regulation will be submitted to Motorsport Ireland who may convene a court of inquiry. **Cameras may be in position before the event.**

The **maximum speed** allowed on a Stage during recce is **60 k.p.h.** unless a lower limit is indicated by a traffic sign or a written instruction issued by the Organisers.

Traversing on the Stage in the wrong direction is expressly forbidden and carries a 5 minute penalty.

If you are not sure of being clear of any stage by 3:30p.m., you should not start the Stage.

The number of runs you will be allowed over the Stages is **3. That’s 3 times!**

## Article 7

### ENTRY CRITERIA

In the event of an excess of 150 entries being received the following criteria will be applied to all entries received from the opening to the closing date of entries, reference 2007 Yearbook Appendix O Art 2.6.

- a) 30 entries allocated as per 2007 Yearbook– Preference will be given to first time National B driver licence holders with licences issued in 2006/2007.
- b) 50 National B Licence Holders as per Appendix ‘O’.
- c) County Cavan Motor Club members who assisted the club with running events (Entry must be accompanied by details of assistance provided).
- d) All other applicants whose entry has been received on time.

The Promoters reserve the right to postpone, cancel, or abandon the event or any part thereof. The promoters reserve the right to refuse an entry without assigning a reason.

# DECLARATION OF INDEMNITY.

(a) "I have read the Supplementary Regulations issued for this event and agree to be bound by them and by the General Competition Rules of the Royal Irish Automobile Club/Motorsport Ireland. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry or of my being permitted to take part in this event I agree to save harmless and keep indemnified County Cavan Motor Club, the Royal Irish Automobile Club, Irish Motorsport Federation Ltd. t/a Motorsport Ireland, and their respective officials, servants, representatives and agents from and against all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of death, injury, loss of or damage to the person or property of myself, my driver(s), passenger(s) or mechanic(s) (as the case may be) howsoever caused arising out of or in connection with this entry or my taking part in this event and notwithstanding that the same may have been contributed to or occasioned by the negligence of the said bodies, their officials, servants, representatives or agents. Furthermore, in respect of any parts of this event on ground where Third Party Insurance is not required by law, this agreement shall in addition to the parties named above extend to all and any other competitor(s) and their servants and agents and to all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of loss of or damage to the person or property of myself, my driver(s), passenger(s) or mechanic(s).

In the case of MI Licence Holders only certificates on the official MI or FIA Medical Forms will be accepted.

(e) Any indemnity and/or declaration as prescribed by sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) above which is signed by a person under the age of 18 years shall be countersigned by that person's parent or guardian, whose full names and address shall be given. Furthermore, the parents and/or guardians of persons under 18 years of age shall grant permission to MI and the Irish Sports Council to carry out tests in accordance with the Irish Anti-Doping Rules (GCR Part XX) in the following form:
